

Kris is an ecologist with interests in global environmental change and its linkages to human, animal and ecosystem health. Kris investigates the relationships between environmental and social influences on health, focussing on infectious as well as non-communicable disease outcomes, disease vectors and zoonotic hosts. Kris often tries to forecast spatial and temporal patterns of disease risk from local to global scales as a result of global change. Kris is a co-Director of the Centre on Climate Change and Planetary Health at LSHTM.
